## **Junkwize Privacy Policy**

www.junkwize.com is a general audience web site, intended for users of all ages. Personal information of all users is collected, used and disclosed as described in this Statement of Privacy.

### **Collection of your Personal Information**

Junkwize collects personal information, such as your e-mail address, name, home or work address or telephone number. Information collected by Junkwize is used solely for the purpose of responding to enquiries, billing and registration. Junkwize does not collect any information about your computer hardware and software.

### **Use of your Personal Information**

Junkwize collects and uses your personal information to process enquiries. It is possible that Junkwize may also use personal information to inform you of other products or services available from Junkwize and its affiliates. Junkwize may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

Junkwize does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. Junkwize may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external business partners about a particular offering that may be of interest to you. In those cases, your personal information (e-mail, name, address, telephone number) is not transferred to the third party.

### **Cookie Policy**

#### **What is a cookie?**

Cookies are text files containing small amounts of information which are downloaded to your personal computer, mobile or other device when you visit a website. Cookies are then sent back to the originating website on each subsequent visit, or to another website that recognises that cookie. Cookies are useful because they allow a website to recognise a user's device.

Persistent cookies – these cookies remain on a user's device for the period of time specified in the cookie. They are activated each time that the user visits the website that created that particular cookie.

Session cookies – these cookies allow website operators to link the actions of a user during a browser session. A browser session starts when a user opens the browser window and finishes when they close the browser window. Session cookies are created temporarily. Once you close the browser, all session cookies are deleted.

Cookies do lots of different jobs, like letting you navigate between pages efficiently, remembering your preferences, and generally improve the user experience. They can also help to ensure that adverts you see online are more relevant to you and your interests.

### **Cookies used on the Website**

Cookies collect information about how visitors use the Website, for instance which pages visitors go to most often, and if they get error messages from web pages. These cookies don't collect information that identifies a visitor. All information these cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous. It is only used to improve how the Website works.

There are also functional cookies to allow the Website to remember choices you make (such as auto fill contacts forms) and provide enhanced, more personal features. These cookies can also be used to remember changes you have made to text size, fonts and other parts of web pages that you can customise. They may also be used to provide services you have asked for such as watching a video or commenting on a blog. The information these cookies collect may be anonymised and they cannot track your browsing activity on other websites.

### **Using browser settings to manage and opt-out of cookies**

The Help menu on the menu bar of most browsers will tell you how to prevent your browser from accepting new cookies, how to have the browser notify you when you receive a new cookie and how to disable cookies altogether. You can also disable or delete similar data used by browser add-ons, such as Flash cookies, by changing the add-on's settings or visiting the website of its manufacturer.
